- 1. Find a new or gently used duffle bag or backpack.**
- 2. Collect items our youth always need:** new or gently used winter gear (mitts, boots, hats, coats, sweater, etc), new underwear and bras (all sizes), new toiletries (travel-sized)
- 3. Make a pot of soup.** We have hot soup all day for youth who come in hungry. Cook up your favorite recipe and freeze it in gallon zip lock bags.
- 4. Sign up to volunteer or mentor at CHA.**
- 5. Help youth explore their creative side.** Pick up art supplies like brushes, paints, markers, sketch pads, canvases.
- 6. Welcome a youth moving into a transitional program with:** Towel set, laundry basket, bedding (Twin XL & Twin), shower caddy
